

DESCRIPTION:

Gear Sector™ slings are designed to utilize a modular weapon attachment system to accommodate a variety of weapon platforms. The auxiliary stub is the most common weapon attachment stub and comes packaged with each sling we produce.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION:

Having multiple weapons utilize a single sling has never been easier with the auxiliary stub. Leave one attached to each weapon in your arsenal and simply click in when ready. In order to attach your Gear Sector™ sling to your weapon with the auxiliary stub, you will need a near receiver sling loop. There are many mounting solutions available, however, we highly recommend our very own SPRE. It was specifically designed to mate with the 1" webbing of our auxiliary stub and is offered in left, right, and ambi versions.

INSTALLATION:



STEP 1:

Collect the items needed to perform the install. You will need an unloaded weapon with a sling loop and the auxiliary stub. Begin by sliding the loose end of the auxiliary stub through your sling loop.



STEP 2:

Double back with the loose end of the auxiliary stub through both loop-locs as shown in the image to your left.



STEP 3:

Double back a second time with the loose end of the auxiliary stub, this time sliding it through the one remaining loop-loc. Be sure to adjust the length of the stub at this time before final tightening.



STEP 4:

Finally, with all the slack removed, pull the loose tail snug to engage both loop-locs. For a clean, finished look, trim any excess tail off with a pair of sharp scissors and heat with a bic lighter to prevent fraying.
